W.J. O'Neil Scores An Ace At The Ryder Cup

Once every two years, the golfing world turns its attention to the Ryder Cup, one of golf's most historic and prestigious championships. Held in the United States every fourth year, the 35th Ryder Cup match took place this September at Oakland Hills Country Club in Bloomfield Hills, Michigan, one of the finest and most historic golfing venues in America.

When W.J. O'Neil was asked to provide our services for the event, we were both honored and excited. Our service department was given the task of helping to set up the air conditioning systems and to start, test and service the *120 HVAC units—all 3,260 tons of cooling!*

The equipment consisted of 20- through 60-ton packaged units and one 300-ton chiller with air handlers. All the equipment was microprocessor controlled with frequency drives and all of it was powered by diesel generator sets. The infrastructure necessary,



both mechanical and electrical, to power, heat and cool the players, fans and media was incredible. The sheer magnitude of all the work we needed to do was made all the more difficult because of a compressed time frame. The HVAC equipment and generators were being shipped to Oakland Hills Country Club from Wisconsin, where they had been used at the PGA National Championship held in mid-August. This was only three weeks before we needed to have the HVAC equipment operational here. Before we could put the units in operation, the generators had to be set and miles of cable had to be run.

Needless to say, we made it. Coordination among the trades was incredibly good, including with those that put together the

buildings and tents—*tents that were almost large enough for an NFL football game.* Everyone did their part to show the world what we can do here in the metropolitan Detroit area.

In the words of Todd Frasano, project manager for Kohler Events, who was responsible for coordinating the entire set up, "I was extremely pleased with all the effort put forth by the W.J. O'Neil Company to help make this event successful. Thank you to everyone involved."
